



Job Title: Construction Foreman – Appalachian Region

Summary:

The primary responsibility of the Construction Foreman is to oversee and direct all field construction activities, focusing on drill site road and location construction, and water impoundment construction. Ensures the proper planning and design to meet company, regulatory and budgetary requirements.

Education/Qualifications:

1. High school education or equivalent.
2. Minimum 10 years civil/site construction experience.
3. Minimum 4 years construction supervisory experience.
4. Minimum 5 years oil & gas construction experience preferred.

Requirements/Skills:

1. Demonstrated technical skills in construction.
 2. Strong interpersonal, communication and team building skills.
 3. Ability and experience in directing and overseeing contractors and employees.
 4. Proven ability to manage multiple tasks.
 5. Experience with estimating, monitoring and forecasting cost and scheduling, including manpower and equipment needs.
 6. Able to read and interpret construction documents.
 7. Basic knowledge of oil and natural gas terminology.
 8. Basic knowledge of Microsoft Office software.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Coordinates and plans short and long term work tasks to meet spud, sales, production, LOE and capital budget goals.
- Communicates with direct supervisor and team members and ensures accurate and timely reporting of critical events.
- Develops and justifies project cost estimates.
- Develops, implements and evaluates inspection and testing program to ensure construction quality, contractor and inspect competency and regulatory compliance.
- Schedules and manages all construction work crews.
- Works to continuously improve asset operations, including new technologies, bid evaluations and cost cutting measures.

- Assists with and coordinates environmental and regulatory-driven construction projects, including compliance and remediation.
- Manages the construction and reclamation of all well sites, drilling pits, fresh water impoundments and roadway repairs.
- Complies with all federal, state and local rules and regulations, policies and procedures for safety, health and environmental protection and ensures same of contractors.
- Provides assistance with production equipment set-up on completed wells as required by Operations staff.
- Provides assistance to JV Midstream partner on all gathering system pipeline construction as needed.
